On **December 12, 2016** the ISubpoena Professional System was updated with new updates, enhancements and modifications.




#1 – Now all notes added to subpoenas are listed on the display pages.



#2 - Streamlined multiple pages display.




#4 – Now you can email the prosecutor directly from the web portal.



#6 – DA case number field added (San Luis Obispo County)




#8 – You can now select all of the county courts for a prosecutor when adding a new prosecutor by selecting the "select all" button.




#9 - Conflict Acknowledged email.




#11 – Conflict start and stop dates will now appear on emails, web portal and calendar pop ups.




#12 – Orange colored case number for subpoenas issues on a date the officer is already listed on the conflict calendar. Email will be sent to prosecutor to identify this conflict.
