

## ISubpoena Professional Version 4.0 Update

On **December 8, 2017** the ISubpoena Professional System was updated with new updates, enhancements and modifications. Customers that have subscribed to the annual update and maintenance plan will automatically have access to these new features and enhancements.

Access to ISubpoena will not change. You should be able to access ISubpoena with your current bookmarks and shortcuts. We recommend using Google Chrome as the default browser for ISubpoena but other browsers will also work fine.

**ISubpoena App Users:** Please update your app to the new version 4.0.12082107 from the apple app store or the Google play store. If you have issues, please delete your current ISubpoena app first before downloading and installing the ISubpoena version 4.0 app. If you have any issues please do not hesitate to contact us



The following are detailed instructions for some of the new features listed above. Please refer to the item numbers associated with the detailed instructions.


#1 & #2 - New "Trailed To" feature. Select new date, time and court.




Officers receive alerts and also a backup email indicating the subpoena was trailed. The new trailed subpoena info is moved on the officer's calendar.




#3 – New Prosecutor Conflict Calendar. Available for Prosecutors and DA admin. Search by court case number and by Prosecutor name on the conflict calendar to only display Prosecutors on that case who are not available.



#4 & #15 – New log entry that will show date and time a specific subpoena was viewed by an officer (On Web Account or Mobile App) but may not have been given a status. Log also displays if user used the web portal or the app.



#5 - New Brady List Management link for DA admin and Prosecutors.



Toggle Brady on or off and print out list of officers using Browser print function.




#6 - New User List Management link for Departments.




List officers within your department and print out list of officers using Browser print function.



**#7** – New "Service Report". Available for Prosecutors and DA admin. See the date a subpoena was served, accepted or conflicted.






#9 - New Menu layout.






## #10 & #11 - Court case number and Agency Case Number labels.




**#12** – Now you can search by court case number and by officer name on the conflict calendar to only display officers on that case who are not available.




#14 – Conflict calendar pop ups now indicate conflict type i.e. Vacation, Training or Other.




**#16** – Added an "On Call" label next to Court case number on "on call" subpoenas in officer subpoena list on Apps.
